Call to order by President Brian Glass at 6:44

A representative of the parks department spoke about improvements to Central Park. Because parks department doesn't have much power when it comes to safety of parks, suggested we contact Major Hagan about enforcing rules of parks. Also suggested we speak with Cooper Hall of Central Atlanta Progress or Diane Cohen about ways to improve parks i.e. taking back parks, walks in the parks, and even movies in the parks. Also parks department gave recommendations about litter control of interior of parks was discussed.

Sharla Jackson gave brief summary of Court Watch 2005 and its progress. Stated she needed more support from C.A.N. side of NPU-M and gave update on defendants that were to be prosecuted and sentenced. Spoke briefly about setting up a neighborhood watch within C.A.N. boundaries and suggested we seek guidance from the Public Safety Committee with respects to this need. Taskforce for the homeless shelter gave brief presentation on funds being sought by the shelter for needs improvement. Shelter representatives stated funds received from city grant would be used for their hotline, transportation, outreach programs geared towards helping people where they are and not bringing them into city. Shelter rep. also states that funding is restrictive and has to be used for that of which the grant application states. Mrs. Terrill motions that C.A.N. does not support the shelter in its seeking of funds; Mr. Terrill seconds the motion; three votes were for and three votes were against; vote was split. Music Midtown representative spoke about M.M. and ways to improve ticket sales. We need to put ticket sales information on CAN website and secure dates at the Civic Center for sales. Spoke about Music Midtown weekend being MARTA's biggest weekend in the year and along with Vibe's music festival and a Braves game; their wouldn't be any off days given to the Atlanta Police Department. Meeting adjourned.
